



Gimel גמל (73) means "complete"

The first appearance of a ג in Scripture is in Genesis 1:1 where God says that He made two "great lights" – ie, the sun and the moon.

The Hebrew word for great is גדל (gadol). גדל has a numeric value of 37.

The Hebrew word for the letter ג is גמל. גמל has a numeric value of 73.

Numeric value of the letter ג = 3

This is the number of the Godhead – Father, Son and Holy Spirit

3 represents divine perfection and perfect witness.

1 John 5:6-9

(6) This is He that came by water and blood, Jesus Christ; not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood, (7) and it is the Spirit that witnesses, because the Spirit is the truth. (8) Because the witnessing ones are three: the Spirit, and the water, and the blood; and the three agree in one. (9) If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: because the witness of God is this that He witnessed concerning His Son.
