Hay אהּ means "Surely!" or "See!" or "Behold!"

Pictogram: Mouth / breath (indicating spirit or revelation)

The first ה in the Bible is the middle letter of the third word = אלהים (GOD)

In Jewish writing, God is often abbreviated to ה' indicating השם (the Name)

Key words with double ה : יהוה = the LORD היה = was

 אהיה = I AM הוה = is

 הנה = Behold! יהיה = will be

Numeric value = 5 5 reveals the grace of God

- Gen 43:34 Benjamin received 5 times more than his brothers
- Gen 45:22 Benjamin received 5 changes of clothing from Joseph
- Num 18:16 Redemption price was 5 shekels of silver
- Matt 14:17 5 loaves of bread fed 5000
- Matt 25:15 The good steward received 5 talents and gained 5 more
