



Zayin זין

Pictogram: Sceptre (a staff – an emblem of royalty, a symbol of sovereign power)
JESUS – the King of kings

Zayin first appears in Scripture in Genesis 1:11.

Then God said "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, fruit trees on the earth bearing fruit after their kind with their seed in them ..."

The word for seed is זרע (zera)

This is the same word as that used in Genesis 12:7 for Abraham's offspring. God's unconditional promises are to the seed of Abraham.

(Gal 3:16) ... the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed ... that is, Christ.

Numeric value = 7

Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He **rested** from all His work which he had created and made ... (Gen 1:27)

ז in Hebrew

indicates a King's sceptre – symbol of authority

Sceptre in Hebrew = שבט)

Rest/Sabbath in Hebrew = שבת)

similar sounds

Psalms 45:6-7

(6) Your throne, O God (Jesus), is forever and ever. A sceptre of uprightness is the sceptre of Your (Jesus) Kingdom. (7) You (Jesus) have loved righteousness and hated wickedness, therefore God, Your God (the Father), has anointed You (Jesus) with the oil of joy (Holy Spirit) above your companions (believers).
