This is the first letter of קדוש – Holy.

Holiness embodies the idea of moral and ethical purity.

However, holy also means separated, set apart. To be sanctified, or consecrated, or made holy, has the primary meaning of being separated unto God who is Himself completely different and separate from the profane and fallen world.

God is holy. Jesus is the Holy One of God. God's people are declared holy – set apart – by faith in Jesus Christ. We are clothed in His righteousness, His holiness. We are to walk in the Spirit so that God may make our experience match our legal right-standing.

God's people are called to be holy - ie, set apart

Because I am holy and be holy consecrate yourselves your God I am the LORD

2 Cor 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
