There are 8 verses in Psalm 121.

There are 9 verses in Psalm 122 ... equals 24 verses in the first three Psalms of Ascent.


This means that Psalm 123 verse 2 is the **26**<sup>th</sup> verse in the Psalms of Ascent series.

There are **18** Hebrew words in Psalm 123:2.

- **18** speaks to Jewish minds and hearts of "life". It's an important word to Jews.
- **18** is the numeric value of the Hebrew word  $\sqcap$  meaning "life".
- **18** is considered a "lucky" number by many Jews.

- <sup>1</sup> Song of the ascents. To You I lifted my eyes; the One seated in the heavens.
- <sup>2</sup> Behold, like eyes of servants to the hand of their master, like eyes of a maid to the hand of her mistress, yes our eyes look to the LORD our God until He will be gracious to us.
- <sup>3</sup> Be gracious to us, LORD, be gracious to us because greatly are we filled with contempt.
- <sup>4</sup> Our soul is greatly filled with the mocking of the self-confident, the contempt of the arrogant.



The total numeric value of all the Hebrew words in Psalm 123 is 8,944 8944 can be expressed as  $86 \times 2 \times 26 \times 2$ 

This cannot be a random result.

86 is the numeric value of the Hebrew word אלהים

is the first word used in the Bible for "God"

26 is the numeric value of the Hebrew word זהוה

יהוה is the word that we say as "Adonai". Adonai means LORD in English.
