Hyssop

Hyssop is a weed – a lowly plant. It has spongy leaves and a woody stem.

Exo 12:22 <u>Hyssop</u> was used to dip and apply the blood to the doorposts at Passover.

Lev 14:4-52 and Num 19:6,18

<u>Hyssop</u> was used in the cleansing of lepers (a picture of judgment on human pride) and in cleansing the tabernacle.

Psa 51:7 David's repentance: "Cleanse me with hyssop."

John 19:29 Jesus on the cross was given sour wine in a sponge on a stalk of hyssop.

Hyssop is a picture of humility.
