

The Hebrew word translated "I am" occurs exactly 37 times in the OT, in referring to the LORD.

I AM: אהיה = 1 + 5 + 10 + 5 = 21 = 3 x 7

And God said, "**I will be** with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain." (*Exo 3:12*)

God said to Moses, "**I am who I am**. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: '**I am** has sent me to you.'" (*Exo 3:14*)
