



Alef      אֵלֶּף      (111 = 3 x 37) means "thousand"

Pictogram: Ox head with horns = Power, leadership

Hebraic idea in אֵ      = God, leader, first, best, beginning

Numeric Value = 1

Hebrew indicates a unit of 1 and also unity.

Gen 2:24      ... a man shall be joined to his wife and they shall become one flesh (ie, 2 = 1)

בשר אחד

Deut 6:4      Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one

שמע ישראל יהוה אלהינו יהוה אחד

Note: יהוה (the LORD) on each side of אלהינו (our God) hints at the Triune Godhead

אֵ in Hebrew = alef

אֵלֶּף means "thousand"

1. Letter אֵ occurs 6 times in Genesis 1:1

Hints at 6 x 1000 : See Rev 20:2-7 = 6 x 1000 years

2. First reference to "thousand" = Genesis 20:16

To Sarah he said, "Behold, I have given your brother a thousand (pieces of) silver.

It is your vindication before all who are with you, and before all that you are cleared."

Notes:

(a) Abraham was married to Sarah. He was also her brother.

We are "married" to Jesus. He is also our brother.

(b) Sarah was vindicated, cleared with a thousand pieces of silver – redemption price.

Jesus bought our redemption.
