## 2 Sam 7:11-16 : Davidic covenant

(11) The LORD also declares to you that the LORD will make a <u>house</u> for you. (12) When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your descendant after you, who will come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom.
(13) He shall build a <u>house</u> for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. (14) I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me ... (15) My lovingkindness shall not depart from him ... (16) Your <u>house</u> and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever ...

John 2:18-21 : The Temple of His body

(18) The Jews then said to Him, What sign do you show us as your authority for doing these things?" (19) Jesus answered them, "Destroy this <u>temple</u>, and in three days I will raise it up." (20) The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this <u>temple</u>, and will you raise it up in three days?" (21) But He was speaking of the <u>temple</u> of His body.

Hebrews 3:4-6 : God's household – Jesus is the Head

(4) For every <u>house</u> is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God. (5) Now Moses was faithful in all His <u>house</u> as a servant ... (6) But Christ as a Son over His <u>house</u> – whose <u>house</u> we are, if we hold fast our confidence and the boast of our hope firm until the end.
