Dalet

דלת means "door"

Pictogram: Doorpost and lintel

Numeric value = 4

The word that follows דלת in a Bible dictionary is דם = blood.

(Numeric value of דם is 44)

Blood had to be applied to the doorposts and lintel of the houses where the Israelites sheltered, so that the angel of death "passed over" them and spared them.

Exo 12:7 ... they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of their houses

Exo 12:13 The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live, and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy.

The blood of the Passover lamb was a pre-figuring of the sacrificial death of Jesus. The blood was placed on the wood frame, at the head and on two sides – ie, in the shape of a cross.

דלת means door or gate
