Pictogram: Opened container. (thought: after **nine** months a womb is opened)

Matt 27:51 And behold, the veil of the Temple was torn in two.

At Jesus' death the way into the Holy of Holies was opened so that all who believe in Him may enter boldly into the presence of God.

Heb 4:14 ... we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God.

Heb 4:16 Therefore, let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Numeric value of ט = 9    9 (3 x 3)    Represents finality, completion, peace in God.

John 17: Jesus' High Priestly prayer – His last recorded prayer before He went to the cross.  
His words in the original Greek = 486 = 9 x 9 x 6

ט in Hebrew

טית in Hebrew sounds like טיט which means potter's clay.

He is the Potter. We are the clay.

2 Cor 4:7 We have this treasure (ie, the Holy Spirit) in earthen vessels, so that the surpassing greatness of the power will be of God, and not of ourselves.

The first Tet in the Bible: טוב = good

Gen 1:4 God saw that the light was **good**, and God separated the light from the darkness.

Jesus is the light of the world. (John 8:12)

The middle verse of the Bible:

Psa 118:8 It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in man.

The first word = טוב

Peace with God. Also peace in God. We find our rest in Him.
